



## Marshal Rewards Scheme

### Introduction

The Marshal Rewards Scheme is part of our ongoing efforts to encourage people to support us by marshaling on events. As we know, the future of motorsport depends on an adequate supply of marshals for each event. In order to run a successful Monaghan Stages Rally, our club requires the assistance of a significant number of marshals from our neighbouring motor clubs. We then must provide the same assistance when those clubs run their events. This task is becoming more difficult and so, we are appealing to all local motorsport enthusiasts to lend a hand; competitors and non-competitors alike.

We appreciate very much the continuing support we receive from our regular marshals. The annual Marshals Draw is an example of this. This Rewards Scheme is designed to favour those who marshal on the most events. In addition to this, rally competitors who marshal on the designated events will be eligible for the Marshal Rewards Scheme as well as gaining priority points for the Monaghan Stages Rally. Priority entries will be based on the highest accumulated points gained on receipt of entries.

### Eligibility

All those benefiting from the Marshal Rewards Scheme must be Monaghan Motor Club members. Membership must be paid in full before the first event that the marshal wishes to count. Qualifying club members must be on the list of people volunteering on behalf of Monaghan Motor Club and approved by Monaghan Motor Club for each event. Motorsport Ireland-appointed Event Officials and club-appointed Event Officials as published in event regulations are not eligible to score points on each relevant event.

### Marshal Rewards

The club will invest €1600 in prizes for a marshals draw. It is proposed that the prize money will be allocated as follows:

No. Events Marshaled	Prizes
2 - 4	5 x €100
5 - 7	3 x €200
8 plus	1 x €500

Note: the number and value of prizes for each category may vary depending on marshal numbers, but the total prize fund will remain at €1600.

### Points

The following points will be allocated to each marshal for the purpose of determining the number of events marshaled and to each competitor for marshaling on these events:

ALMC Endurance Trial	10
Midland Stages Rally	20
Cavan Stages Rally	20
Donegal International Rally (one day)	20
Donegal International Rally (two days)	30
Donegal International Rally (three days)	40
Monaghan Endurance Trial	10
Connacht (Sligo) Stages Rally	20
ALMC Stages Rally	20

Ten (10) places on the Monaghan Stages Rally [2026](#) will be reserved for priority based on the highest number of points earned. The onus is on the marshal/competitor to ensure that all points are allocated correctly.

There will be a draw for merchandise prizes for all others who marshaled and did not win a monetary prize.

The interpretation of the running of this scheme, in case of doubt, will rest with the committee of Co. Monaghan Motor Club CLG.
