Each driver must complete and sign an entry form.

The entire event will be held on private ground. No IRDS is required

Format: The event will consist of driving tests. Navigators are not required. Passengers are not allowed, except for Junior competitors. The regulations for Junior competitors are outlined in App. 91, articles 12.1 to 12.5 inclusive.

Tests: Will be designed for Production, Endurance & Navigation Trial and Retro type cars. 2WD cars only.

Licence Requirements: All drivers must hold a valid 2026 competition licence of the appropriate grade or MSUK equivalent, which must be available for inspection at check in. One event licences will be available at a cost of €25 and **must be pre-booked with the Event Secretary by Wednesday 18th February.**

All cars will be inspected before the start.

Penalties: Failure to start at correct time when notified by the Marshals (unless previously agreed with the COC) will result in a 5 second penalty per minute late being applied. The time taken for each test will be the penalty for that test, with additional penalties as follows: each initial contact with a pylon: 5 seconds, each line fault: 5 seconds, failure to come to a complete stop (box) 5 seconds, failure to attempt to stop (box) max penalty. The maximum loss (including failure) on any test will be the best correct performance overall plus 30 seconds.

Note: THAT ALL LINES DURING A TEST MUST BE CROSSED BY A CAR'S LEADING WHEELS ONLY – i.e., STOP ASTRIDE ALL LINES. THERE IS 5 SECOND PENALTY FOR PUTTING THREE OR FOUR WHEELS (or only ONE) ACROSS A LINE.

Classes

Class 1 All mini and non-mini saloons

Class 2 All front wheel drive and rear wheel drive sports cars and specials

Class 3 All road going cars other than in classes 1 and 2 including Endurance Trial, Navigation Trial and Multi-Venue Autotest cars.

The onus is on the driver to ensure that he/she is entered into the correct class. Ties will be decided by the better time on test 1, and so on. No more than 2 drivers will be allowed per car. Where 2 drivers are sharing a car, a separate entry form and payment must be completed for each driver.

The tests will be designed to suit everyone. Tests will be of an open nature. Use of seatbelts is compulsory.

Tyres: No competition tyres allowed on driven wheels. Random checks WILL be carried out. Anyone in any doubt as to what type of tyres may be used should contact the Clerk of the Course in advance to prevent any misunderstanding on the day.

Awards: 1st Overall & 1st, 2nd & 3rd in each class. Also Best Ladies, Best Beginner and Best Junior Awards. If one competitor is eligible for both Best Beginner and Best Junior, then one award only will be presented.

Prize giving will be held after the event.

INDEMNITIES, DECLARATIONS & UNDERTAKING BY ENTRANTS, DRIVERS AND PASSENGERS

(a) I have read the supplementary regulations issued for this event and agree to be bound by them and by the General Competition Rules and Regulations of MI including the guidelines and regulations contained in Motorsport Ireland's Code of Conduct for Children's Sport. In consideration of the acceptance of this entry or of my being permitted to take part in this event I agree to save harmless and keep indemnified the CMMC CLG/Co. Monaghan Motor Club (Organising Club), Irish Automobile Club Ltd. t/a Royal Irish Automobile Club, Irish Motorsport Federation Ltd. t/a Motorsport Ireland and their respective officials, servants, representatives and agents from and against all actions, claims, costs, expenses and demands in respect of death, injury, loss of or damage to the person or property of myself, my driver(s), passenger(s) or mechanic(s) (as the case may be) howsoever caused arising out of or in connection with this entry or my taking part in this event and notwithstanding that the same may have been contributed to or occasioned by the negligence of the said bodies, their officials, servants, representatives or agents. Furthermore, in respect of any parts of this event on ground where Third Party Insurance is not required by law, this Agreement shall in addition to the parties named above extend to all and any other competitor(s) and their servants and agents and to all actions, claims, costs, expenses and demands in respect of loss of or damage to the person or property of myself, my driver(s), passenger(s) or mechanic(s).

(b) I declare that to the best of my belief the driver(s), passenger(s) possess the standard of competence necessary for an event of the type to which this entry relates and that the car entered is suitable and roadworthy for the event having regard to the course and the speeds which will be reached. I declare that the use of the car hereby entered is covered by Insurance as required by the Road Traffic Act, which is valid for such part of this event as shall take place on roads as defined in the Act.

(c) I understand that should I at the time of this event be suffering from any disability whether permanent, temporary or otherwise which is likely to affect prejudicially my normal control of my automobile, I may not take part unless I have declared such disability to MI, who have, following such declaration issued a licence which permits me to do so.

(d) Any indemnity and/or declaration as prescribed by sub-paragraphs (a) and (b) above which is signed by a person under the age of 18 years shall be countersigned by that person's parent or guardian, whose full names and address shall be given. Furthermore, the parents and/or guardians of persons under 18 years of age shall grant permission to MI and the Irish Sports Council to carry out tests in accordance with the Irish Anti-Doping Rules (Rule No 139) in the following form: "I/We hereby grant permission to MI and the Irish Sports Council to carry out tests as set out in Rule No 139 of the GCRs in accordance with the Irish Anti-Doping Rules."

(e) I agree to abide by and be bound by the Motorsport Ireland Social Media Policy of conduct as per Appendix 126 of the current MI Yearbook.

*** IMPORTANT – COMPETITORS UNDER 18**

Competitors under 18 years of age (Minor) must be entered in the event by the holder of a Minor Entrant Licence who must countersign this entry form, below. A Minor Entrant who is not the parent/legal guardian of the Minor, must be Garda Vetted. Where an adult sits in the same car as a Minor competitor, the adult must be the holder of a Minor Entrant Licence, if they are not the Minor's Parent/Legal Guardian this licence must include Garda Vetting. It is not permitted to have two minors in the same vehicle. In the event that the Minor Entrant Licence holder is not parent/legal guardian, please supply Minor Entrant Nomination Form.
