The Event is an open Endurance Trial, promoted and organised by the Co. Monaghan Motor Club (CMMC), hereinafter called the promoters. It will be held under the International Sporting Code of the FIA, the General Competition Rules of Motorsport Ireland (MI), Appendix 35 of the current MI Yearbook, these supplementary regulations and any final instructions issued before the start of the event.

1. All entries must be FULLY PAID and submitted online before Tuesday 1st September 2026. Telephone entries will not be accepted.

2. Entry forms must be FULLY COMPLETED and submitted with an online payment made payable to **The Co. Monaghan Motor Club CLG** using the details below.

**The entry fee is € 295 (including IRDS/BRDS insurance and other charges)
(Less a deduction of €7 per person for those aged 16 / 17)**

3. Late entries will run at the back of the field – no exceptions.

4. Entries are limited to 70 starters.

5. Online entry: CMMC will use Sportity as the official notice board. The competitors/users need to download the Sportity app from AppStore or Google Play and insert the noticeboard channel's password **MONEND26** - Link to entry form will be available on the event channel.

6. All drivers and navigators must hold a valid competition licence of an appropriate grade, and all drivers must be listed on the IRDS/BRDS database which is published weekly on the Motorsport Ireland website.

7. Cars will start at 1 (one) minute intervals, except where directed otherwise by the organisers.

Classes

As per updated Appendix 35.15.1, the entry will be divided into six classes, as follows:

A1: Cars built to Endurance specification up to 1000cc

A2: Cars built to Endurance specification from 1001 to 1400cc

B: Navigation Trial cars up to 1400cc, (Navigation Trial cars as defined in appendix 33, including such cars fitted with cages and Open Sports cars fitted with cages).

C: Navigation Trial cars from 1401 to 2000cc, (Navigation Trial cars as defined in appendix 33, including such cars if fitted with cages and Open Sports Cars fitted with cages including 4WD Cars).

D: Front Wheel Drive Retro type cars (retro cars as defined in appendix 33).

Cars Registered before 1977

E: Rear Wheel Drive Retro type cars (retro cars as defined in appendix 33).

Cars Registered before 1977

F: All other RWD Sports Cars.

If you enter the incorrect Class, you will be reclassified

Tyres for Endurance Events:

In conjunction with Appendix 35 – Standard Regulations for Endurance Trials: Article 21.14, this list Will outline the Tyres permitted for the 2026 Endurance Trials

The Control list is ONLY relevant for Endurance Specification Cars in Classes A1 and A2 and from 1st January 2026 it is mandatory on ALL wheels [including spare wheels]

Awards

- **The Overall Winner will be decided from Class A1 and A2 (Endurance Class) competitors only.**
- 1st, 2nd & 3rd Overall
- 1st, 2nd & 3rd Class
- Class A2 will be sub-divided into Master, Expert, Semi-Expert, Novice, Beginner.

Amalgamation of Classes may be announced at signing-on before the Event.

ELIGIBILITY FOR AWARDS:

Those receiving awards for overall placing will not be eligible for class awards.

The organisers reserve the right to re-classify a competitor considered ineligible for a class, and/or amalgamate as required. Classification will be based on the performance of the Driver and not the Navigator as per 2026 Championship Registrar:

* Master	This class qualification is: Finishing in the first three overall in an Endurance Trial /Championship or Targa Rally in the previous 12 months, or winning any event, except a Navigation Trial or Rally, promoted under an MSUK or MI Permit.
Expert	This class qualification is: Finishing in the first six overall in an Endurance Trial / Championship or Targa Rally in the previous 12 months, or winning any event, except a Navigation Trial or Rally, promoted under an MSUK or MI Permit
Semi Expert	This class qualification is: Finishing in the first fifteen overall in an Endurance Trial / Championship or Targa Rally in the previous 12 months, promoted under an MSUK or MI Permit
Novice	This class qualification is: No class wins in an Endurance Trial / Championship or Targa Rally in the previous 12 months, or any event promoted under an MSUK or MI Permit
Beginner	First year of Endurance Trials / Championship or Targa Rallies

8. Start Order

Competitors will be seeded based on the information provided on the Entry Form and from information, which may be found elsewhere, for example, endurance events and previous championship results.

9. Force Majeure or Baulking

The organisers will not accept any claim from competitors concerning either Force Majeure or Baulking.

PENALTIES

Penalties as per Appendix 35 of the current Motorsport Ireland Yearbook.

SCRUTINY REQUIREMENTS – ALL VEHICLES.

Scrutiny Requirements as per Appendix 2 and Appendix 35 of the current Motorsport Ireland Yearbook

NB: Competitors in ALL CLASSES must wear helmets, (these helmets do not have to be in date but do need to be in good condition)

NB: All cars must have a current, valid NCT / M.O.T certificate, unless exempt.

Driving Standards

Driving standards will be monitored carefully. Please be sensible and safe, this is a fun event; show us your skills, not your bravery or foolhardiness. Poor driving standards will likely result in exclusion and the Clerk of the Course decision is final.

*** IMPORTANT – COMPETITORS UNDER 18**

Competitors under 18 years of age (Minor) must be entered in the event by the holder of a Minor Entrant Licence who must countersign this entry form, below. A Minor Entrant who is not the parent/legal guardian of the Minor, must be Garda Vetted. Where an adult sits in the same car as a Minor competitor, the adult must be the holder of a Minor Entrant Licence, if they are not the Minor's Parent/Legal Guardian this licence must include Garda Vetting. It is not permitted to have two minors in the same vehicle.
