Where an adult sits in the same car as a Minor competitor, the adult must be the holder of a Minor Entrant Licence, if they are not the Minor's Parent/Legal Guardian this licence must include Garda Vetting. It is not permitted to have two minors in the same vehicle. In the event that the Minor Entrant Licence holder is not parent/legal guardian, please supply Minor Entrant Nomination

The route will be approximately 80 miles in length. There will not be a petrol halt. Controls and time points will define the route as well as vias which must be visited in the order stated.

All drivers and navigators must hold a valid competition licence of an appropriate grade and all drivers must be listed on the IRDS/BRDS database which is published weekly on the Motorsport Ireland website.

1st Overall, 1st, 2nd, 3rd in each class.
